Austin Robertson

The group of cricketers who have made themselves available for the Golf Classic and Calcutta have done so to support both charitable causes, particularly the Ocker Support Trust that was established to assist Austin Robertson during this difficult time for him.

Many of you would recall his football achievements fondly and his record below speaks for itself:

- 251 games for Subiaco Football Club
- Subiaco Best and Fairest: 1965 and 1968
- WAFL Premiership player: 1973
- WAFL leading goalkicker: 1962, 1964, 1965, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972

In the 1970s, Austin was employed by Kerry Packer and was one of the central figures in the establishment of World Series Cricket. It was Austin and his business partner John Cornell (Strop from the Paul Hogan Show) who made a proposal to Kerry to play televised exhibition matches.

Packer took this idea, fleshed it out and when the Australian Cricket Board refused Channel 9 the exclusive broadcasting rights, he established World Series Cricket in 1976.

Austin was a key figure in the set-up and administration of this series. Austin has been a close friend and past manager of many cricketing greats including Dennis Lillee, Alan Border and Shane Warne. It is for this reason that he has received the generous support of these folk for this event.

Manna Soup Kitchen

The Manna Soup Kitchen is Manna Industries' longest running community program, feeding approximately 100 homeless people every evening at Weld Square, Northbridge.

Bev and John Lowe started the Manna Soup Kitchen in 1996 by cooking a meal in their kitchen at home and then travelling to Northbridge to feed the homeless out of the boot of their car.

The Soup Kitchen has now grown to be Perth's largest humanitarian food outlet providing a two-course meal, which includes a drink and a side of bread, to the street people of Perth.

Manna Industries has also started the school breakfast program, the winter school uniform project, and the Manna Kids Kitchen Cooking School.
